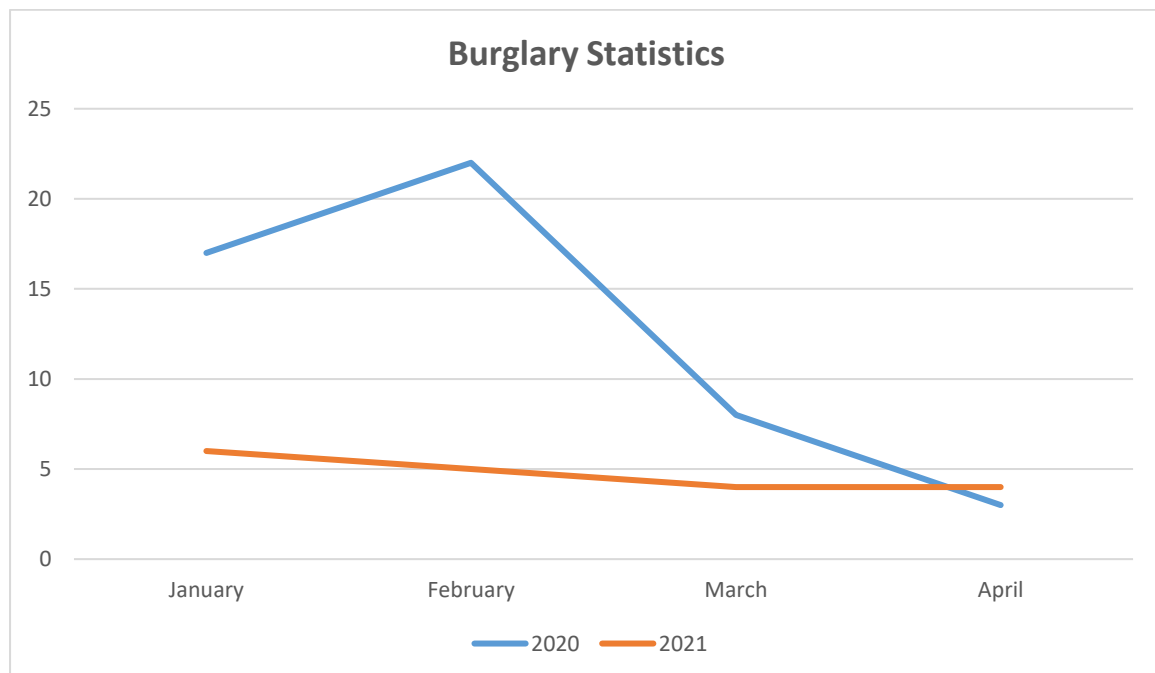


BURGLARY

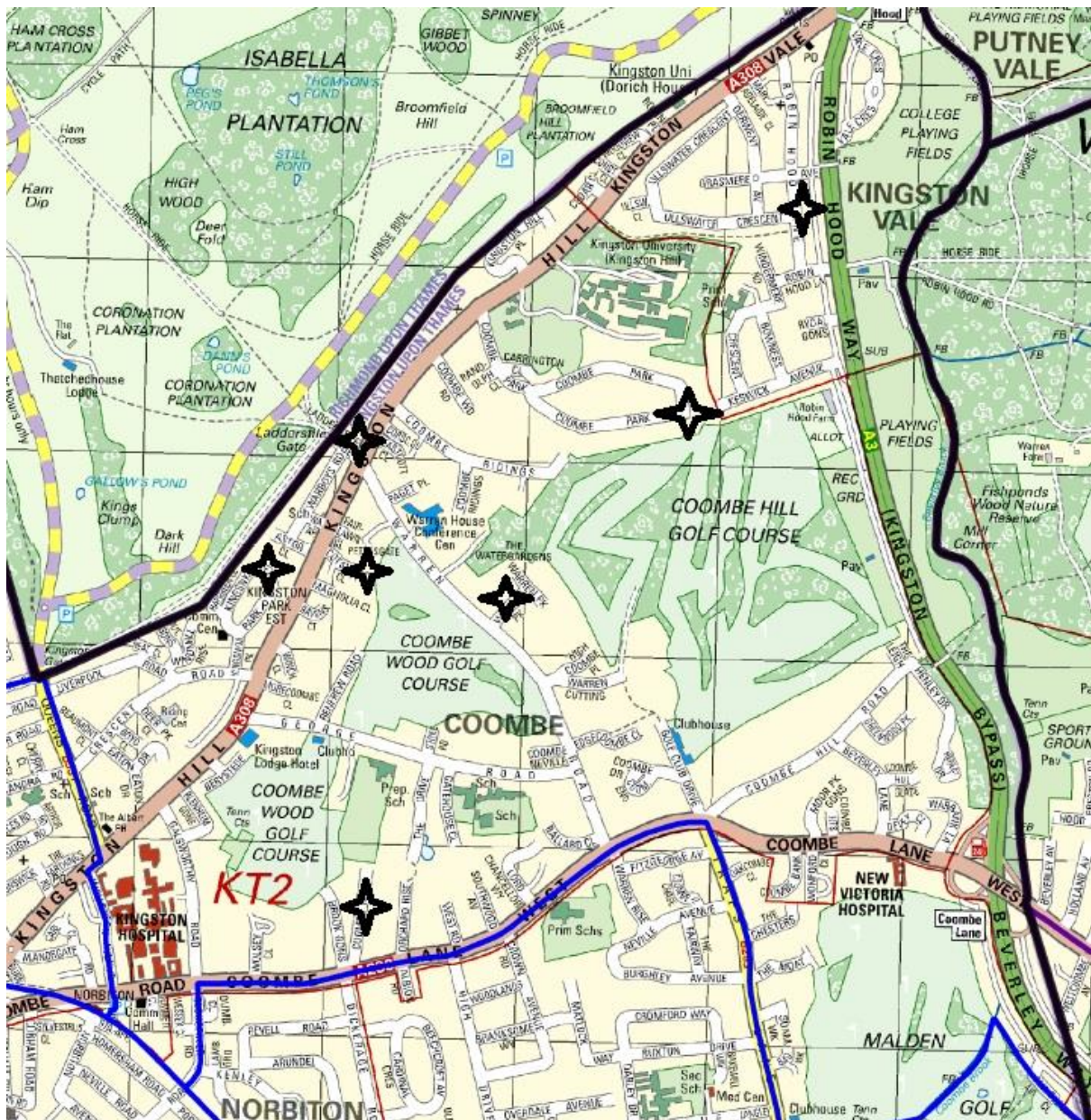

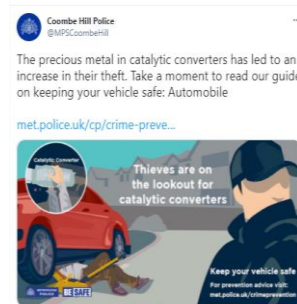
